

Information regarding District 5020 Ambassadorial and World Peace Scholarships

Application Procedure and Schedule

Procedure: Candidates should contact a local Rotary Club to schedule an appropriate interview with the Foundation or Scholarship Chair of that Club. (Contact information for the District 5020 Clubs may be found elsewhere on this Rotary5020.org website.) Candidates should know that Clubs may sponsor only one candidate each for the Ambassadorial and World Peace Scholarships. If a Club has already made its selection for this competition, candidates are free to approach a different Club; in fact, the initially approached Club typically makes suggestions about establishing such contact. *Given this competition, candidates are encouraged to begin contacting Clubs in October or November.*

Schedule:

1. **March 3, 2008.** Completed applications from candidates are due to the sponsoring Clubs unless the Club has specified an different [sometimes earlier] date. Once candidates are identified by Clubs, the Club Sponsor and the candidate are encouraged to notify Ron Adkins or Nels Granewall by e-mail so that we may be alerted to watch for in-coming materials.

2. **April 1, 2008.** Club endorsed applications must be in the hands of either Ron Adkins (for US applicants) or Nels Granewall (Canadian applicants)

Interviews are 45 minutes long, and there will be a group reception for all candidates and various District 5020 officials on the evening of Thursday, May 1st.
